

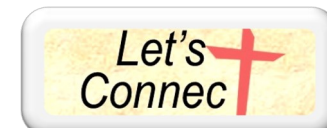

Also needed— new volunteers to work in the clothing room give away, sorting area, and food area weekly on Mondays and Tuesdays, and someone who can help with grant writing.

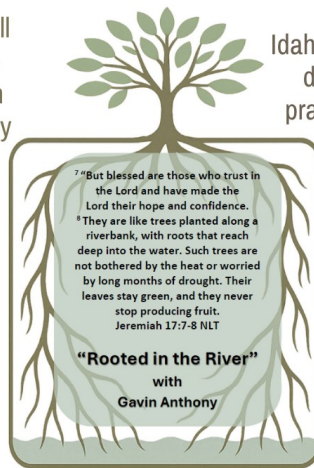
